1. Slicing Cucumbers - 6
2. Pickling Gherkin Cucumbers - 6
3. White Cabbage - 2
4. Sweet Corn cobs - 6
5. Carrots, long and slender (1” stems) - 6
6. Carrots, short and stubby (1” stems) - 6
7. Table Beets (1” stems) - 6
8. Slicing Beets (1” stem) - 6
9. White Pickling Onions - 6
10. Yellow Onions - 6
11. Green Peppers - 2
12. Red Peppers, sweet - 3
13. Yellow Peppers, hot - 3
14. Red Tomatoes - 6 (stems left on)
15. Green Tomatoes - 6 (stems left on)
16. Red Romano Tomatoes - 6
17. Green Romano Tomatoes - 6
18. Cherry Tomatoes - 6 (stems left on)
19. Grape Tomatoes - 2 clusters, mostly ripe
20. Yellow Tomatoes - 6
21. Heritage Tomatoes - 6 (there are some 300 varieties of HERITAGE or Heirloom Tomatoes. Variety must be named)
22. Yellow Beans - 15
23. Green Beans - 15
24. Garlic - 6 heads (4 stems, roots off, cleanliness counts)

In classes 25 to 28 judging is done on shape, form, fitness, uniformity and freedom from blemish. **All dirt must be rinsed off, “do not scrub”.**

25. White Potatoes (12 on a tray, must be named)
26. Red Potatoes (12 on a tray, must be named)
27. Late Potatoes (12 on a tray, must be named)
28. Dutch Sets Onions, (12 on a tray)
