## **CLASS 8 - QUILTS**

### **THE ONTARIO ASSOCIATION OF AGRICULTURAL SOCIETIES ANNUAL HAND-QUILTED CHAMPIONSHIP QUILT & *MACHINE-QUILTING QUILT/WALL HANGING* COMPETITION**

#### **ELIGIBILITY, RULES & REGULATIONS**

##### **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- A. Entries must be solely made & hand-quilted quilts, machine-quilted quilts/wall hangings by the exhibitor & exhibited & judged at a local Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies (OAAS) Fair to be eligible for this competition.
- B. Entry hand-quilted quilts must be a minimum of 324” measured on the perimeter & for machine-quilted quilts/wall hangings total perimeter measurement must be a minimum of 192” or 480 cm. Note the article can be square, rectangular, etc. (Smaller quilts & wall hangings won’t be eligible to proceed to the next levels of competition).
- C. Machine Quilted Quilts/Wall Hangings must have visible machine quilting.
- D. Judging will occur at local fairs & district levels. A Provincial Grand Champion hand-quilted quilts, machine-quilted quilts/wall hangings will be selected at the annual OAAS Convention.
- E. Upon making an entry into the OAAS Quilt Competition, the Exhibitor agrees to participate in any promotional activities related to the Competition.
- F. The winning OAAS Champion Hand-quilted Quilt, Machine-Quilted Quilt/Wall Hanging won’t be eligible to compete in any future District &/or Convention OAAS competition.
- G. The winner’s name & pattern to be displayed at the fair on sign provided by OAAS.

For more information, call Director, Barb Gill. Each exhibitor may enter only one exhibit per section. Bring quilts to upstairs hall for judging. A “Quilt” consists of 3 layers of material stitched together: a top layer, a soft filler layer & a backing layer. TURN up approximately 12” at the bottom right corner of the hanging quilt to show the backing, & attach your name tag in this triangle with a safety pin. Names must be covered.

DETAILS COUNT: Be sure to remove all pencil/chalk marks, have no knots showing, measure to check for proper size, seam allowances trimmed & pressed toward the darker colour etc. Quilts may have been made by a Group (unless stated otherwise), but if so, must be entered under the Name of the Group with a CONTACT Name & Address of one member of the Group. Study the above RULES of the OAAS Quilt Competitions as well as the General Rules & Regulations as the front of the Book for sections 1 to 4 & 7. If your quilt or article is eligible for the OAAS Competition, please print the name of Quilt Pattern Design on the back of the Exhibitor Tag & also mark “OAAS Yes” or “OAAS No” on the back of the Exhibit Tag to indicate whether or not you wish to enter this competition.

## LOCAL FAIR COMPETITIONS

1. Each local fair is entitled to send only the GRAND CHAMPION HAND-QUILTED QUILT & GRAND CHAMPION MACHINE QUILTED QUILT/WALL HANGING judged the best of show to the District Competition **OR** If any entry wins GRAND CHAMPION or BEST OF ALL ELIGIBLE QUILTS/WALL HANGINGS at more than one Fair, the other Fairs at which this quilt was entered & won, should enter their RESERVE CHAMPION or SECOND BEST OF SHOW OF ALL CLASSES quilt in the District Competition.  
**NOTE:** If an Exhibitor wins GRAND CHAMPION or BEST OF SHOW or BEST OF ALL ELIGIBLE quilts/wall hangings at other than his/her own fair, or at more than one Fair, the Exhibitor must consider the Agricultural Society nearest his/her home address as the one from which the quilt will be sent to the District meeting.
2. An Exhibitor who wins more than one Best of Show titles with a different quilt at different Fairs shall be entitled to enter each winning quilt to compete at the District Competition.
3. Local Homecraft Divisions are requested to judge a GRAND CHAMPION or BEST OF SHOW of all ELIGIBLE quilts & a RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION or SECOND Best of Show of all ELIGIBLE quilts.

The GRAND CHAMPION & the RESERVE GRAND& CHAMPION are judged from all first & second prize ELIGIBLE quilts.

### Special Rules for Sections 1-4 entry

Quilts MUST be hand-quilted & MUST be a minimum of 32 1/2" measured on the perimeter

**Prizes - 1<sup>st</sup> \$20.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$15.00, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$10.00**

Best In Show Quilt wins an extra \$5.00

*In memory of Evelyn Silk donated by her family.*

1. Quilt, Pieced & Appliqued, hand-quilted.
2. Quilt, Pieced, hand-quilted
3. Quilt, Hand-quilted Design on a plain top layer or pre-printed panel
4. Quilt, ANY OTHER, h&-quilted, at least 72" x 90", name technique (ie: embroidery, combined techniques, etc.)

### Sections 5 – 8

**Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup> \$15.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$10.00, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$5.00**

5. Machine Quilted Quilt/Wall Hanging, minimum perimeter of 192" or 480cm (can be square, rectangular, etc).
6. Quilt/Wall Hanging, pieced (pieced by exhibitor, quilted by another person using a long arm quilting machine. Top only to be judged – include name of person who did the quilting)
7. Quilt, Open Class, any adult size, any technique, any quilting style (hand, machine, long arm), tied.
8. Quilt Top, pieced, ready to be quilted, (top only), any adult size

**Sections 9 - 10**

**Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup> \$9.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$7.00, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$5.00**  
plus *Gift Certificate from **Thimbles & Things, Orillia***

These must be approximately 36" x 44" - **NOT** a wall hanging

9. Baby's Crib Quilt, HAND-QUILTED
10. Baby's Crib Quilt MACHINE QUILTED or TIED
