CLASSES

- 1. Up to Age 3**
- 2. Ages 4-6**
- 3. Ages 7-9**
- 4. Ages 10-13**

RULES

1. Each participant will be given a scorecard and a bandana.
2. Completing a contest will yield the following points; 6 points for a 1st, 4 points for 2nd, 2 points for 3rd and 1 point for participation.
3. Total scores for each age will result in Class placement (1st place receives a rosette). Each contestant will receive a participation ribbon.

Up to Age 3: Parental Guidance required

Corn husking (parents hold cob if desired, but no assistance)

- First one to finish wins (2nd, 3rd)

Husk Round up:

- Must move a scattered pile of husks to the bag/barrel. No pieces can be left behind!
- First one to finish wins (2nd, 3rd)

4-6 years:

Rubber boot toss

- First throw: Furthest wins (2nd, 3rd)
- Second Throw: Closest to bull's eye wins (2nd, 3rd)

Farmer Relay:

- Contestants sprint to the finish line with a plastic egg on a plastic spoon
- If the egg falls off, pick it up and continue.
- First one to finish wins (2nd, 3rd)

7-9 years:

Shoe toss (rubber boot toss if muddy, same rules as above)

- Shoes must be placed loosely on foot, and tossed with a kick.
- First throw: Furthest wins (2nd, 3rd)

- Second Throw: Set a series of rings on track, marking the bull's eye. Closest to bull's eye wins (2nd, 3rd)

Farmer Relay: (Requires a partner)

Partner one starts behind the start line; partner 2 runs out. Pair advances by tossing the egg and catching it. Only successful catches count. If unsuccessful; re-throw from same position. Repeat until crosses finish line. Note; egg holder cannot take any steps towards finish line. -First one to finish wins (2nd, 3rd)

10-13 years:

Corn Toss (use corn from smaller ages)

- Husked corn from round one must be tossed into a pot of water, a set distance away.
- Contestants are eliminated if their toss does not go in.

Agricultural Quiz: 1 point for each correct answer. Tie for 1st 2nd or 3rd results in bonus questions.

ALL AGES:

Pencil Draw (Or lollipop) –bonus points to overall score

Colourful unsharpened pencils with tags are placed end down into a bucket, and kids pull out the pencil of their choice. They get to keep the pencil, and they also get bonus points according to the number on the tag of their pencil.

Ribbons: 1st, 2nd, 3rd for each event (10 each) Participant (12-50 max)

Rosettes for 1st in each age category (4)
