CLASSES

- 1. Up to Age**
- 2. Ages 4-6**
- 3. Ages 7-9**
- 4. Ages 10-13**

RULES

1. Each participant will be given a nametag with their first name + age.

Up to Age 3: Adult Guidance required

Corn husking (shucking) (adults hold cob if desired, but no assistance)

- First one with all husks on the ground & off the cob wins (2nd, 3rd)

Husk Round up:

- Must move a scattered pile of husks to the bag/barrel. No pieces can be left behind!
- First one with all their pieces in the bag wins. (2nd, 3rd)

Animals in a Hay Stack:

- Animals are placed in a hay stack
- First child to find 2 animals wins (2nd, 3rd)
- If there's a tie: first to find an animal wins

4-6 years:

Rubber boot toss

- Rubber boot is thrown from behind the line (1 or 2 hands, over/under throws allowed).
- Toss is marked by the furthest point of the bail, with a small flag. Furthest wins (2nd, 3rd) - Tie Breaker: Re-throw

Egg on a spoon:

- Contestants sprint to the finish line with a hard boiled egg on a spoon
- If the egg falls off, pick it up and return to start line. Continue.
- First one to finish wins (2nd, 3rd) - Tie Breaker: tied contestants re-race

Quarters in a Hay Stack:

- Quarters are placed in a hay stack. Contestants are given 1 minute to find/collect quarters.
- Largest qty of quarters wins (2nd, 3rd) - Tie Breaker: first to find a quarter wins

7-9 years:

Small Bail Toss

- Small bail of hay is thrown from behind the line. Toss is marked by the furthest point of the bail, with a small flag. Furthest wins (2nd, 3rd) -Tie Breaker: Re-throw

Egg on a spoon:

- Contestants sprint to the finish line with a chicken's egg on a spoon
- If the egg falls off, pick it up and return to start line (broken eggs are replaced)
- First one to finish wins (2nd, 3rd) - Tie Breaker: tied contestants re-race

Apple Roll:

- Apple is rolled from behind the line. Apple is marked by the furthest point of the apple, with a small flag. Closest to the line without going over wins (2nd, 3rd) -Tie Breaker: Re-roll

10-13 years:

Medium Bail Toss

- Medium bail of hay is thrown from behind the line. Toss is marked by the furthest point of the bail, with a small flag. Furthest wins (2nd, 3rd) -Tie Breaker: Re-throw

Egg on a spoon:

- Contestants sprint to the finish line with a chicken's egg on a spoon
- If the egg falls off, pick it up and return to start line. Contestant continues race.
- First one to finish line wins (2nd, 3rd) - Tie Breaker: tied contestants re-race

Apple Roll:

- Apple is rolled from behind the line. Apple is marked by the furthest point of the apple, with a small flag. Closest to the line without going over wins (2nd, 3rd) -Tie Breaker: Re-roll

Each contestant will receive a participation ribbon.
