Judging will be done on the following:

Look, Creativity and Taste

Prizes: 1st \$5.00; 2nd \$3.00; 3rd \$2.00

1. **A decorated cake** - 9" square (white cake) - using the theme **COWBOYS & COWGIRLS**. Your decoration must be 75% edible and 25% artificial
2. **Bownie Pizza** – Cook a brownie mix in a round pan, making it become a pizza shape & decorate it, making it look like pizza toppings ie: jellybeans, gummy worms, etc)
3. **Banana Chocolate Chip Muffins** - 3 muffins (medium size)
4. **Baked Cookies** - 3 varieties (3 cookies of each) Peanut Butter, Oatmeal Raisin and White Chocolate Chip & must be displayed on a plate
5. **White Cupcakes** - 3 medium size & must be iced & must be displayed on a plate
6. **Homemade Trail Mix** - must have at least 5 different kinds of mix (must have 1 cup of Trail Mix). List the ingredients on a card & attach to the bag
7. **Hand Cookies** – before baking, shape the dough to the outline of your hand, then bake as you normally would. Feel free to decorate cookies with icing & sugar. Place **3** on a paper plate
8. **Chocolate Brownies with Chocolate Icing** - 3 (2" squares pieces).
9. **Chocolate Chip Cookies** (open to ages 10-15) & must only be 8 cookies & display on a firm disposable plate and covered with plastic bag with a twist tie. Cookies must be no smaller than 2" in diameter & no larger than 3" in diameter. Cookies will be judged according to the Homecraft Judging Standards established by the OAAS. The winner from our Fair will be eligible to enter the District competition. The winning cookies will go to the OAAS Convention 2013
